Mr Jeffery G. Ulma, AICP, is Director of the Planning Department for the Town of Cary. Jeff received his Bachelor's degree in Geography from UNC-Chapel Hill and a Master's degree in Urban Planning from the University of Arizona. He began his career with the Pima ("Pee-ma") County Department of Planning & Development Services located in Tucson, Arizona. He worked there six years as a Planner, Senior Planner, & Principal Planner. He then moved to Greenville, NC where he served as Pitt County Planning Director for nine years. Jeff taught urban and regional planning classes at East Carolina University (ECU) and is now an adjunct faculty member at North Carolina State University (NCSSU) in the Master of Public Administration (MPA) program. He teaches a course called "Government & Planning." He co-authored a feature article for the Winter 2007-08 edition of *The Public Manager*, entitled "Citizen Involvement in the Digital Age."

A member of the American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP), Mr. Ulma is active in professional planning activities, having served as a board member of both the Arizona

and North Carolina chapters of the American Planning Association (APA).

Tim Bailey, P.E. is Director of Engineering for the Town of Cary. Tim received his Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering in 1987 from North Carolina State University and has worked for the City of Winston-Salem from 1987 to 1989 and the Town of Cary from 1989 to present. Tim has more than 23 years experience in municipal engineering including management and project administration. The Town of Cary Engineering Department manages several functions including: traffic engineering, transportation engineering, stormwater engineering, sanitary sewer systems engineering, portable water systems engineering, reclaimed water systems engineering, development plan review, real estate, construction inspection, code enforcement and standards enforcement. He has been involved in over \$1 billion in capital project design and construction serving in a variety of roles.
